Full Terms and Conditions

The following outlines the terms and conditions for all rebates specifically relating to the rainwater tank rebates under SA Water's H2OME REBATE Scheme.

Eligibility

- 1) Home owners and tenants are eligible to apply for rainwater tanks provided the home was built (or development application lodged) before 1 July 2006 and has not involved a significant extension/addition since 1 July 2006. A significant extension/addition is a home addition with a roof area of not less than 50 square metres and incorporates a toilet, laundry or hot water service. Homes built on or after 1 July 2006 are required to install a plumbed-in rainwater supply as part of building regulations. Homes built after 1 July 2006 do not incur 'retrofit' costs and are not eligible for a rebate.
- 2) The registered owner or tenant of the property must be the applicant. Strata or Community Titled properties may be eligible for a rebate for each separately owned premise dependent on the nature of the system installed on the property, with eligibility determined by SA Water on a case by case basis.
- 3) The rebates are not available for industrial and commercial properties, including resale. The rebates are not available to strata companies or managing agents, commercial home builders or land developers.
- 4) The H2OME REBATE scheme replaces the existing SA Water and South Australian Government Drought Response Rebate Scheme and the Rainwater Tank and Plumbing Rebate Scheme.
- 5) The Rainwater Tank & Plumbing Rebate Scheme is available to all South Australian Residents who have rainwater and an alternate water source, (ie mains, dam, bore or river water) plumbed into their dwelling to either the WC, HWS or all cold water outlets in the laundry. Properties that have a rainwater only supply may be eligible for a partial rebate.

General Terms & Conditions

- 6) The applicant must provide original receipts to be eligible for the rebates. It is the applicant's responsibility to make their own copy for their personal records as original receipts will not be returned. Application forms will not be accepted if they are incomplete or do not have the original receipts attached. The amount of rebate will not exceed the costs incurred for installing a plumbed in rainwater system as indicated by receipts.
- 7) Tenants need to provide a written letter of permission from their landlord with their application to be eligible for the rebate.
- 8) Rebates are not available for rented, leased or hired products. Products that form part or all of an insurance claim are not eligible for rebates.
- 9) SA Water will not be responsible for items lost or delayed in the mail, nor any remittance delayed due to incorrect rebate applications.
- 10) SA Water reserves the right to conduct field inspections to verify your claim in the event that SA Water finds the applicant in breach of these terms and conditions, the rebate amount will need to be repaid to SA Water. SA Water may wish to conduct an on site inspection of the installation to ensure plumbing standards have been complied with and to finalise the application.
- 11) The applicant agrees and acknowledges that SA Water accepts no liability for the performance, quality or installation of equipment eligible for this rebate. The applicant agrees that they will indemnify SA Water for any liability or claim arising in relation to a product they have installed in order to claim a rebate.
- 12) SA Water and its employees have taken all reasonable care to accurately and correctly convey the scope of the H2OME REBATE scheme and of the applicant's entitlements under the scheme, and shall not be liable for any inadvertent errors. Furthermore SA Water does not assert that the scheme is in all cases appropriate for every resident.
- 13) SA Water reserves the right to alter or change the terms and conditions of the H2OME REBATE scheme or to cancel the rebate scheme at any time.
- 14) Information provided on the application form may be used to measure and monitor the success of the scheme. Rebate recipients consent to and recognise that SA Water may contact them to conduct research about the products purchased.
- 15) An applicant's personal information will only be used or disclosed for purposes relating to the H2OME Rebate Scheme in accordance with the State Government Information Privacy Principles. If you wish to update or access the information that we hold about you, please contact us.

Rainwater Tanks Criteria

- 16) Rainwater tanks eligible for rebates must have capacity of 1000 litres or greater and must be plumbed into the house to at least one of the following: toilet cistern, all laundry cold water outlets or hot water service.
 - 17) For claim for purchase of a rainwater tank, original receipt indicating the purchase of a rainwater tank of no less than 1000 litre capacity purchased on or after 1 July 2006.
 - 18) For buried and partly buried rainwater tanks a risk assessment form (available from SA Water) signed by the Plumbing Contractor is also required. It is strongly recommended that, prior to engaging a plumber, you obtain agreement from the plumber that he/she will provide the relevant documentation following completion of the work.
 - 19) For a rebate for plumbing, a licensed plumbing contractor must have conducted the work on or after 1 July 2006 as evidenced by the date of the fully itemised plumbing invoice. An SA Water Plumbing Certificate of Compliance signed by an appropriately licensed installing plumber is required for installation, including a fully itemised invoice from the installing plumber detailing the services rendered.
 - 20) For the \$600 rebate, eligible items include: plumbing connecting a tank to a designated outlet inside the home i.e. toilet cistern, all laundry cold water outlets or hot water service; appropriate backflow prevention device installed on the property water service; pressure pump (if installed) manual or seamless automatic switching device between tank and any mains water or other appropriate supply labour (for licensed plumber); sundry materials. Stormwater connections and electrical connections are not eligible for the rebate.
 - 21) For the \$800 rebate, eligible items include rainwater tank, plumbing connecting a tank to a designated outlet inside the home i.e. toilet cistern, all laundry cold water outlets or hot water service, appropriate backflow prevention device installed on the property water service; pressure pump (if installed); manual or seamless automatic switching device between tank and any mains water or other appropriate supply; labour (for licensed plumber); sundry materials. Stormwater connections and electrical connections are not eligible for the rebate.
 - 22) For the \$200 rebate, eligible items include a new, an additional or replacement rainwater tank that is connected to at least one eligible fixture.
 - 23) An additional \$200 rebate is available where the installation includes an eligible seamless automatic switching device - a device which switches automatically from rainwater to an alternative supply (such as mains water) and visa-versa without any manual intervention, to best optimise the use of rainwater when available or new plumbing by a licensed plumber to supply rainwater to at least two different eligible fixtures types (toilet, all laundry cold water outlets; hot water service). The \$200 component of this rebate is not retrospective and will be implemented as of 1 November 2007.
 - 24) The maximum available rebate is \$1000 (\$800 rebate plus the additional \$200 'bonus').
 - 25) SA Water will issue a rebate cheque within 60 days of receiving your completed application form, including the required documents and receipts and subject to the approval of your application.
 - 26) All property owners and occupiers are responsible for the quality of water collected and contained in and supplied from any rainwater tank located on the property and for the appropriate cleaning and proper ongoing maintenance of all private infrastructure on the property including the rainwater tank and all associated pipes, fittings and fixtures.
- Note: All rainwater tank installations necessitate an additional backflow prevention device to be installed at the meter by SA Water. The alteration to the water meter will occur in due time at no cost.
